

UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

The minimum standard for entry to a degree course at university is 42 level 3 credits.

Students should aim to gain the best they can so they have the best chance of gaining entry into their preferred courses.

Literacy Requirements:

4 reading and 4 writing credits at level 2



Numeracy Requirements:

14 mathematics credits at level 1 or higher

To be admitted to the **University of Auckland** you must gain the university entrance standard and **be selected into a programme**. The selection process is based on the quality of your results. You will be allocated a rank score based on your best 80 credits at level 3 or higher over a maximum of **five approved subjects and a maximum of 24 credits per subject**.

Any credits at 'Excellence' will be multiplied by 4

Any credits at 'Merit' will be multiplied by 3

Credits at 'Achieved' will be multiplied by 2

Students with 80 credits at excellence would have a rank score of 320

Students with 80 credits at merit would have a rank score of 240

Students with 80 credits at achieved would have a rank score of 160

Students will generally need a rank score of 120-320 based on a mixture of credits to get into University of Auckland.

Please remember: Gaining level 3 does not mean you have University Entrance and having University Entrance does not mean you will get into the course of your choice.
