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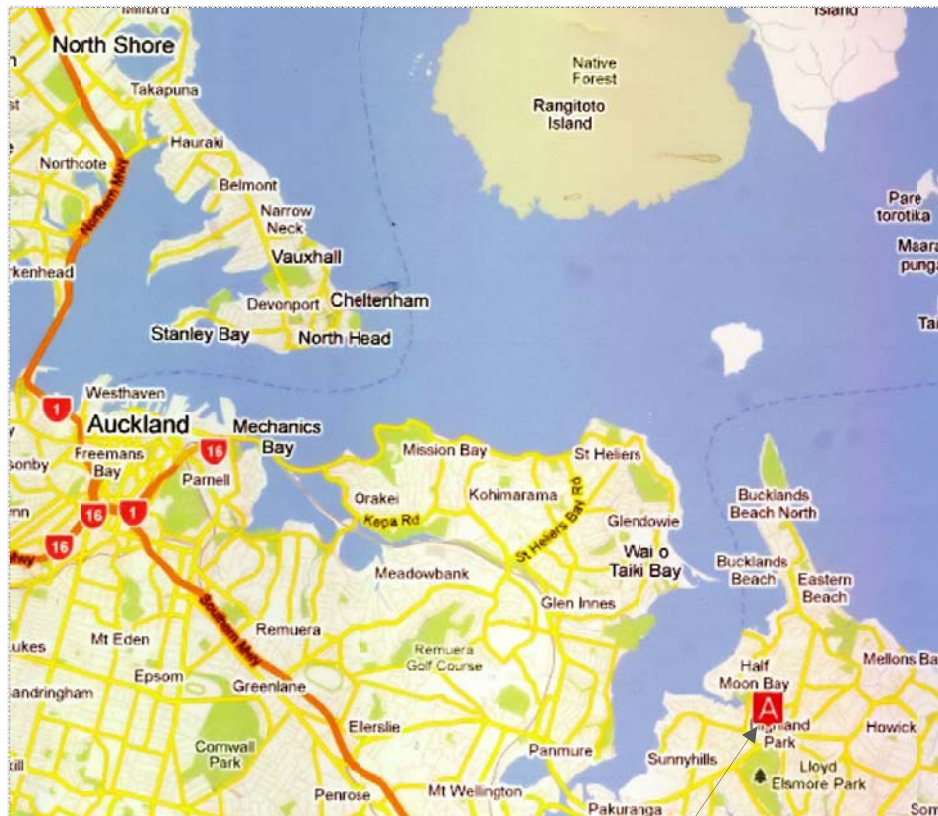


In October 2009 we received formal notification from the University of Auckland of the names of former Pakuranga College students who graduated in the 2009 spring graduation ceremony. The list contained a staggering 201 names. When we add in the 126 students from Pakuranga College who graduated earlier in the year it brings the total number of former Pakuranga College student graduations in 2009 for Auckland University alone to 327.
