INTERNATIONAL STUDENT CAREGIVER ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF CONDITIONS



We are aware of the following conditions outlined in the Homestay Information Booklet for Caregiver of International Students. We will always notify Pakuranga College if my international student is in breach of these conditions.

DRIVING AND CAR OWNERSHIP:

International students are not permitted, under any circumstances, to purchase, drive, or own a car. This applies even when the student is over 18 years of age.

TRAVEL CONDITIONS:

International students are not allowed to undertake unsupervised overnight travel unless it is with an approved tour company, as organised by the student's agent or family and family permission has been received.

OVERNIGHT STAYS:

International students are not permitted to stay overnight with friends unless the family they are planning to stay with has approved police vets, permission has been obtained from the host family and family with whom the student will stay. Contact details, weekend plans, and intended supervision must be obtained. Students are not to be left unattended overnight.

AFTER SCHOOL & WEEKENDS:

All students are expected to return to their caregiver or homestay home, each night in time to eat dinner with the family. Any after-school activities can be shared with the caregivers in advance and plans made around these.

International students must always let their host family know where they are and when they will be home.

Curfew Times

All students are expected to return to their caregiver or homestay home, each night in time to eat dinner with the family. These Curfew times need to be discussed between the homestay family and the student and take into account any after school activities the student may be involved in, ie sports, dance or other extra-curricular activities.

SCHOOL UNFORM:

International students in Year 9-12 must wear full school uniform, including PE uniform. Uniforms can be purchased from the uniform shop situated on the school grounds. For further guidance on school uniforms please visit the school website: www.pakuranga.school.nz

ABSENCES:

International students are required to be at school every day. Absences from school for Illness must be approved by the host family. Absences must be reported to school before 9:00am on the day of the absence via the SchoolBridge app or call 09 534 76159. Students over 18 years old are not considered adult students while they are still at school therefore they are not allowed to make their own decisions about attendance.

NB: All of the above items are included in the "Homestay Information for Caregivers of International Students" booklet which gives comprehensive guidance for host families and is given out by our Homestay Co-ordinators.
