PAKURANGA COLLEGE YEAR 10 OPTION CHOICES FOR 2019

GO TO THE ONLINE COURSE BOOK TO READ ABOUT YEAR 10 SUBJECTS ONLINE.

The course book can be found on the College website, under the Learning Tab. Choose the Course Selection option.

All students in Year 10 take compulsory one year courses in:

English | Mathematics | Physical Education/Health | Science

All students in Year 10 take the compulsory 1/2 year course in: **Social Science**

Options: Year 10 students also choose from a range of subjects in two **OR** three other Learning Areas, according to their personal interest. **Students must choose from at least two Learning Areas.**

Languages: (A) Māori (1/2 YEAR OR FULL YEAR)

If students wish to study Māori, they can choose the 1/2 year course or the full year course. If they choose the full year course, students will choose only one other subject - either Arts or a Technology subject.

(B) German, Japanese, Chinese, Spanish (FULL YEAR)

If students wish to study German, Japanese, Spanish or Chinese, they will choose only one other subject - either an Arts or a Technology subject.

The Arts: Dance, Drama, Music, Visual Art (1/2 YEAR COURSE)

Technology: Fabric Technology, Food Technology, Graphics, Electronics, Product Design and Computer Studies (1/2 YEAR COURSE)

If you have chosen a Full Year Language course, choose only one more course. If you have chosen a Language for a 1/2 year, choose two options. **If you have not chosen any Languages, then choose three options from the two Learning Areas of Technology and The Arts.**

You should have no more than three ticks in total, from at least two Learning Areas.

When students are ready to choose their option subjects for 2019, they should click on the green buttons to select these.

Students must submit their subject choices by: **SUNDAY 4 NOVEMBER, 2018.**

Once you have submitted your subjects, the Careers Advisors will arrange to meet with you in November in order to discuss your choices for 2019.
