- Level 2 students should remember that scholarship applications to tertiary providers are based on Level 2 credits.
- Level 3 students must choose a minimum of four UE (University Entrance) subjects if they intend to study at University.

All students will have a one-to-one interview with the Careers Department to discuss and confirm their chosen subjects.
